- CLASS 1 **BROOD MARE** – Grade 1 Brood Mare (RID, AID, SID) with own foal at foot. **Qualifier for the Snowford GB Breeding Championship.** The two highest placed Grade 1 Mares (RID,AID,SID) with own foals at foot, born in Great Britain, by an RID sire, or if one or both have already qualified, the Mare(s) next in line will go forward to the Final at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show at Weston Lawns Equitation Centre, Bulkington, Coventry, Warwickshire, on the 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> September 2009 where the Champion will receive the Snowford Breeding Trophy, a sash and £400 prize money, the Reserve Champion will receive a sash and £200 prize money. In the final each mare and foal will be judged as a pair.
- CLASS 2 **FOAL** – Out of mare in class 1, eligible for, (2a) Grade 1 Irish Draught Register or (2b) Grade 1 Sport Horse Register
- CLASS 3 **YOUNGSTOCK** – 3a; Colt,filly or gelding yearling, 3b; two/three year filly or gelding, two year old colt, by a RID stallion and out of a Grade 1 Mare (RID, AID, SID) - (class 3b will be split if sufficient entries). **Classes 3a & 3b are qualifiers for the NFU Mutual Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge.** The two highest placed Pure Breds from each age group, yearling (filly, colt or gelding), two year old (filly, colt or gelding), three year old (filly or gelding), identified on the Grade 1 Irish Draught Horse Register, by RID sire out of Grade 1 mare (RID,AID,SID) or if one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line down to 3<sup>rd</sup> place only in each age group, will qualify for the final at the IDHS(GB) Annual Breed Show at Weston Lawns Equitation Centre, Bulkington, Coventry, Warwickshire on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> September 2009. ***In the Final***, there will be three classes each awarding £150 to the 1<sup>st</sup> placed semi-finalist, and £100 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed semi-finalist. The two semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship, where the Champion will receive a trophy and £150 prize money, the Reserve Champion will receive £100 prize money. **YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP follows class 3; 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 2a,3a &3b eligible**
- CLASS 4 **MARE/GELDING 16hh and under** – 4 year old and over, RID, AID, SID graded Mares or Mare/Gelding by RID Stallion and out of a Grade 1 Mare (RID, AID, SID)
- CLASS 5 **MARE/GELDING 16.1hh and over** – 4 year old and over, RID, AID, SID graded Mares or Mare/Gelding by RID Stallion and out of a Grade 1 Mare (RID, AID, SID)
- Followed by **PURE BRED IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placed horses in the classes 1, 2a, 3, 4, 5 eligible

**Commencing 10.00 am** This show is a Qualifier for the **Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge**.
